# **Bibliography Format**

#### Alphabetical list - author's last name first

- No author use first significant word in title
- Do **NOT** include page numbers for books
- Do include page numbers for periodicals

## BOOKS

## Author last, first name. <u>Title</u>. (underlined) City where published: Publisher, Publication year.

Examples:

Simon, Jeffrey D. <u>The Terrorist Trap: America's Experience with Terrorism</u>. Bloomington: Indiana University Press, 2001.

Anderson, Sean and Sloan, Stephen. Historical History of Terrorism. Lanham: Scarecrow Press, 1995.

## PERIODICALS / MAGAZINES OR NEWSPAPERS

Author last, first name (if any). "Title of Article" (in quotation marks). Magazine/Newspaper name (underlined). Volume or issue number if applicable. Date of publication: Page number(s).

Examples:

Beyer, Lisa "Osama bin Laden: The Most Wanted Man in the World." <u>Time</u>. Vol 158. (Sept. 24, 2001): 52.

Anwar, Iqbal. "Bin Laden, A Tool for Taliban." United Press International. (Aug 8, 2001): 47.

## **ENCYCLOPEDIA**

## Author (usually found in tiny letters at end of the article). "Title of Article". Encyclopedia name (underlined). Edition year or number. Place of publication: Company, Date. Page number(s).

## Examples:

Gouttierre, Thomas E. "Afghanistan." <u>World Book Encyclopedia.</u> 2000. Chicago: World Book Inc., 2000, 92.

"Kamloops." <u>Encyclopedia of British Columbia</u>. 2000. Madeira Park: Harbour Publishing, 2000. 374.

#### ELECTRONIC DATA BASE (EbscoHost databases)

Author last, first name. "Article Title." <u>Title of Journal, magazine, newspaper, etc.</u> Volume and issue number. Online. Name of subscription service. Date of Access. Keyword.

Example:

Beyer, Lisa. "The Most Wanted Man In The World." <u>Time</u>. Vol. 158, #13. 09-24-2001. Online. Elibrary-bigchalk. 25 April, 2002. Terrorism.

## ARTICLE IN AN ONLINE REFERENCE DATABASE (e.g. Worldbook online)

Author. "Title of article." <u>Web site title</u>. Latest update of the site. Producer/Sponsor of the Site. Access date. URL. Keyword.

Example:

Helms, Christine Moss. "Bin Laden, Osama." <u>World Book Online Reference Center</u>. 2006. World Book, Inc. 10 May 2006. <a href="http://www.worldbookonline.com/wb/Article?id=ar749895">http://www.worldbookonline.com/wb/Article?id=ar749895</a>. Terrorism.

#### WEB PAGE:

#### Author. "Article title." <u>Name of site</u>. Access date. <URL>.

Example:

Lenander, Johanna. "Make Clothes Not War." Fashion Net. 5 Oct., 2002. <fashion.net/news/>.

## VIDEO /DVD

Title. Director. Producer. Medium. Distributor, Date.

Example:

Islam - Empire of Faith. Gardner, Robert. Videocassette. PBS Video, 2001.
